Name of Position : **Organizational Goalie Coach**

Role:

Provide overall guidance and feedback to the Chatham Kent Cyclones AAA organization for the overall improvement of all team goalies in the organization.

Expectations:

- Design and implement drills
- Participates in team goalie evaluation and selection process together with head coaches
- Act as a liaison between the goaltenders and the head coach
- Help goaltenders with mental preparation and routine
- Assess game and practice performance to identify strengths and areas of development
- Help the goaltenders deal with pressure and poor performances
- Attend a minimum of one (1) practice and one (1) game per month per team to
- Evaluate and give direction and feedback to team coaches, goalies and parents
- Assist with coaches who may be having goaltending issues and require direction
- Attend Tryout sessions to provide feedback to team coaching staff
- Assist with 4 coaching clinics during the regular season
- Provide assessments to coaching staff and goalies on overall performance goals
- Attend Alliance Hockey Goalie Clinic held in the off season
- Plan on ice practices once per month with all Cyclone teams
- Communicating regularly with head coaches (i.e. planning drills for team practices, addressing performance, etc.)
- Provide Development Goals for each Goaltender in the Chatham-Cyclones organization
- Support goalies, parents and head coaches with online/offline resources and direct consultation
- Follow the principles as outlined in the Hockey Goaltending Development Program
