The scholarship recipients are determined on the basis of academic achievements, hockey involvement and community involvement.

2019 Chatham-Kent Cyclones Scholarship Eligibility & Application Requirements

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to receive a scholarship, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Have participated for a minimum of three (3) full hockey seasons as a Cyclone player
- Enrolling in post-secondary full-time studies in Canada or entering a trade program for the **first time**

Required Documentation:

- Chatham-Kent Cyclones Scholarship Application Form
- A letter from the candidate (maximum 500 words, single spaced) outlining their contributions to hockey, what the game of hockey has meant to them and other information such as volunteer or community involvement
- One (1) letter of reference from a current school teacher on official letterhead (non-relative)
- One (1) letter of reference from an existing or former Chatham-Kent Cyclones hockey coach *(non-relative)* whom has coached you
- Copy of Official School Transcript is mandatory

Note:

- Applicants will be scored based on their personal contribution to hockey, community involvement, volunteering and academics.
- Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$500 each.
- Application deadline July 15, 2019; scholarships winners will be announced on or before August 15, 2019.
